2018 WATERFOWL RATES

DAILY (one half hour before sunrise to 2:00 p.m.)

- **\$650.00 / one or two hunters**
- **\$870.00 / three hunters**

We have a maximum of three hunters per guide while hunting from field blinds and a maximum of two hunters per guide while hunting from boat blinds. Guides do not carry a gun. **Rates include** water, soft drinks, guide, dog, decoys, waterfowl blind, boat, bird cleaning and transportation from Bozeman (or other agreed meeting place) to hunting area and return. **Rates do not include** gun fees (if any), meals, lodging, guns, shells, tips, licenses. Gun fees vary from \$75-\$150 per person per day and are applicable only if you are shooting a private ranch.

RESERVATIONS

A 50% deposit within 5 days of your verbal reservation will confirm your hunt. If your deposit is not postmarked within 5 business days, your space will be canceled. **Balance is due upon arrival.** All payments are to be made by cash or check. Each participant must sign an acknowledgement of risk and acceptance of responsibility form. Make check payable to Dennis Kavanagh – Montana Bird Hunts

CANCELLATIONS

All payments are NON-REFUNDABLE unless the client refills his/her canceled space. Client is responsible for purchasing his/her own trip cancellation insurance and emergency medical evacuation. If Dennis Kavanagh cancels the hunt then payments made to Dennis Kavanagh or Montana Bird Hunts will be refunded. There will be no refunds or credit for no-shows, inclement weather or any unused portion of your hunt.

TRANSPORTATION

Bozeman, Montana has the nearest commercial airport to our waterfowl hunts. Alaska, American, Allegiant, Frontier, United and Delta have regular daily flights. You can rent a car at the airport.

GEAR

Some gear you should bring: camouflage clothing (foul weather jacket, rain pants, coat, waterproof hat with visor, wool knit hat, waders or knee-high insulated rubber boots, sweater or wool shirt, gloves), safety glasses, sunglasses, lip balm, sun screen, water bottle and insulated underwear. You will be hunting between 4,000 and 6,000 feet so be prepared for inclement weather. You must supply your own shells and gun. I recommend a 12 gauge shotgun. A good ice chest is needed to transport your birds.

TRIP CANCELLATION / MEDIVAC INSURANCE

Clients are responsible for their own trip cancellation insurance and emergency medical evacuation.
